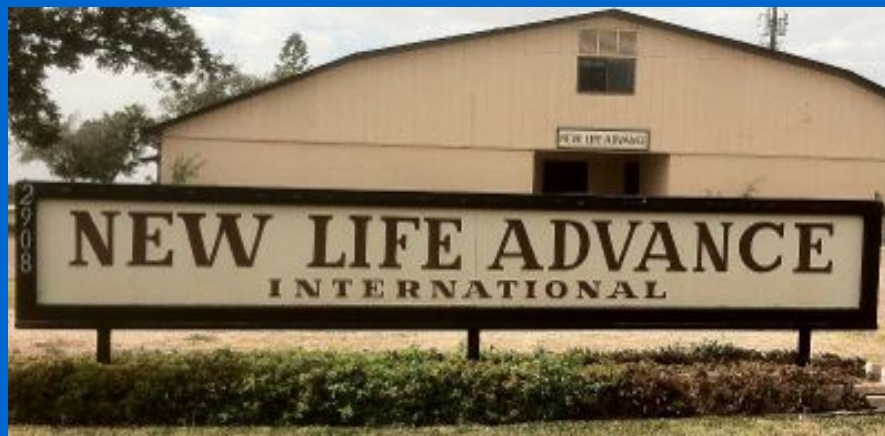


# *We Survived!*

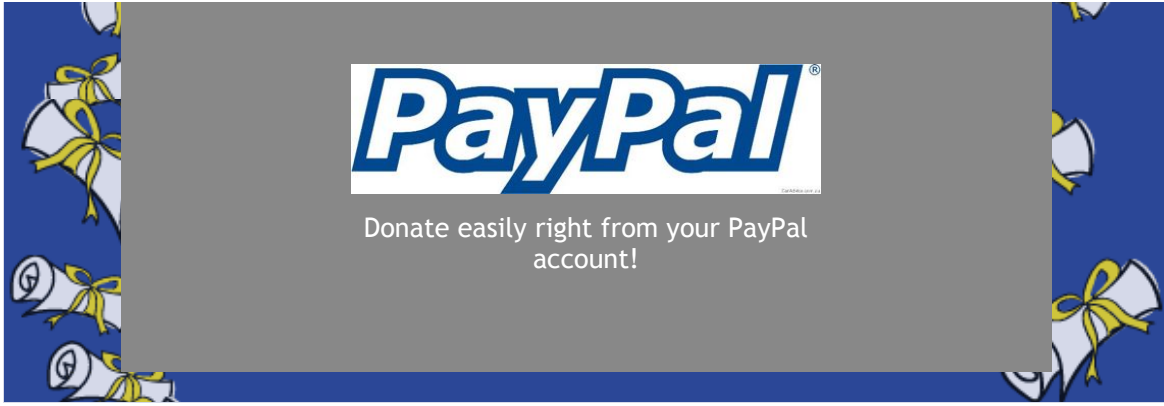
